How to Enter:

1. If you are between the ages of 6 and 18, write an essay about how a book you've read or how books in general help build a better world. Then enter for a chance to see the Yankees, meet a player, and take a bow on the field.

Entries will be judged by NYPL staff on the quality of the writing and the author's ability to address the prompt.

2. Email your review to youthservices@nypl.org by August 1 and include your first and last name, age, phone number, and nearest branch library. You can also send your review by postal mail. Make sure we receive it at the following address by August 1:
